The environment is highlighted with child friendly colours and equipped with a play area meeting international standards. OPD services are supported by efficient nurses and investigations are done under their supervision. The close proximity of OPD to Laboratory/Radiology services offer the option of investigations to be performed on the same day. Appointments for our consultants can be pre-booked telephonically through our 24 hour central booking facility.
- Emergency department:-Emergency department is located in the ground floor of the Hospitals, next to the front entrance of the Hospitals. We offer 24 x 7 access and consultant cover in the emergency department to our young patients with urgent and emergency conditions. Day care observation facility is available in the

department. Any paediatric patient needing admission will be attended by our inhouse paediatric resident and will be subsequently discussed with our on call consultant. All admission to ward and PICU will be done under the consultant on call. All sick children will be seen by the consultant. All admitted patients in the intensive care unit will be seen by the intensives also.

- o **Inpatient care**:- Inpatient care for children is offered for wide range of acute and chronic health conditions. Inpatient care is supported by expert consultant cover, 24 hour service of resident doctors, excellent nursing service, in house pharmacy, and diagnostic imaging & physiotherapy services. Parents or main care provider is allowed to stay with the child. The environment is safe, functional and comfortable with a bed for parent to sleep in each room.
- O Growth and development Assessment: Childhood is a time of rapid growth and change. We provide health services that focus on the growth and development needs of infants, children and young adults. Our electronic medical recording has been facilitated with growth charts; which are extrapolated from anthropometric measurements recorded during initial assessment. All children attending the Paediatric OPD are screened for developmental delay with age appropriate developmental screening tools.
- Patient education and counselling: We offer counselling and education services to all child and family who come to Kumaran Hospitals. We are pleased to offer counselling services to child and family either individually or together depending on the needs. Child's condition and the treatment options will be discussed in detail. Child wellness classes are given. Group health education programmes are conducted as part of special day celebrations, for example, education on different aspects of breast feeding in breast feeding week.
- Paediatric immunization:- Immunisation clinic works from 9am to 10AM-Monday to Saturday, located in the ground floor of the Hospitals. Clinic is conducted by friendly quality staff and nurses. Clinic provides ideal opportunities to receive child's vaccination without waiting alongside other unwell patients. All

the vaccines as per the National Immunization Schedule and other optional vaccines are available in the clinic. We have best vaccine storing and handling measures as per the CDC recommendations.

- Super specialities support:- We offer high quality specialist support services including cardio, neuro, nephro, gastro and urology services to our young patients who offers advanced diagnosis and treatment for diseases.
- Well baby clinic:- Well baby examinations are an important way to monitor child's growth and development. Service of a neonatologist is available in our well baby clinic. Well baby examinations include mainly the measurements of child, weight, length/height, head circumference etc, head to toe physical examination, growth and development assessment and nutritional assessment of the child. Follow up services are provided for all newborns. Mothers are helped to understand and manage the infants maturation and development.
